

We encourage you to take these assets and create your own unique broadcast and run of show! However, if you'd like to follow our tried and true recommendations, the steps are below:

- First steps
 - [Create new broadcast](#) from within the Socialive portal
 - Name your broadcast Self Recording (or something similar 😊)
 - Within the Studio, upload the media assets and overlay files
 - [Media](#) - located in Sources (left panel of Studio)
 - [Overlays](#) - located in the bottom panel under Scene Preview
 - [Change recording quality to Full HD 1080p](#) - located in Settings (right panel of Studio)
 - [Apply background](#)
 - Media asset: Self Recording background image
- [Setting up run of show](#) - this article details how to select layouts for each scene and drag and drop media assets and live sources into each scene to set up your recording. This also details how to enable overlays. Follow these steps for each Scene below:
 - Scene 1
 - Layout: Standard
 - Media asset: Self Recording intro card
 - Overlay: Self Recording 10-second timer
 - Scene 2
 - Layout: One Grid
 - Live source: your camera feed
 - Overlay: Self Recording title overlay
 - [Adjust the size, positioning, and padding of the overlay](#)
 - Size 1750x984
 - Padding X: 85
 - Padding Y: 70
 - Toggle on show [name tags](#) within Overlays and modify your info and theme to adjust the look and feel
 - Scene 3
 - Layout: Two Circle Pip
 - Live source: your camera in a circular source
 - Media: Self Recording product slide 1
 - Duplicate Scene 3 to create Scene 4
 - Update slide with Self Recording product slide 2
 - Duplicate Scene 4 to create Scene 5
 - Update slide with Self Recording product slide 3
 - Duplicate Scene 2, and then drag the newly-created Scene 3 thumbnail to become Scene 6 (right after product slide 3)
 - Scene 7
 - Layout: Standard
 - Media asset: Self Recording end card
 - Review your Run of Show

- Start the Recording
 - Click Start Recording
 - After a short countdown, your recording is now live!
 - Click on the Scene 2 thumbnail, review in Preview, and click the red Send Live button
 - Alternatively, you can double click a scene across the top of the studio to send that scene live immediately
 - Send each subsequent scene live as you're ready (or mix up the order!).
 - When you're done, click End Recording.
- You've just created your first mock Self Recording!
